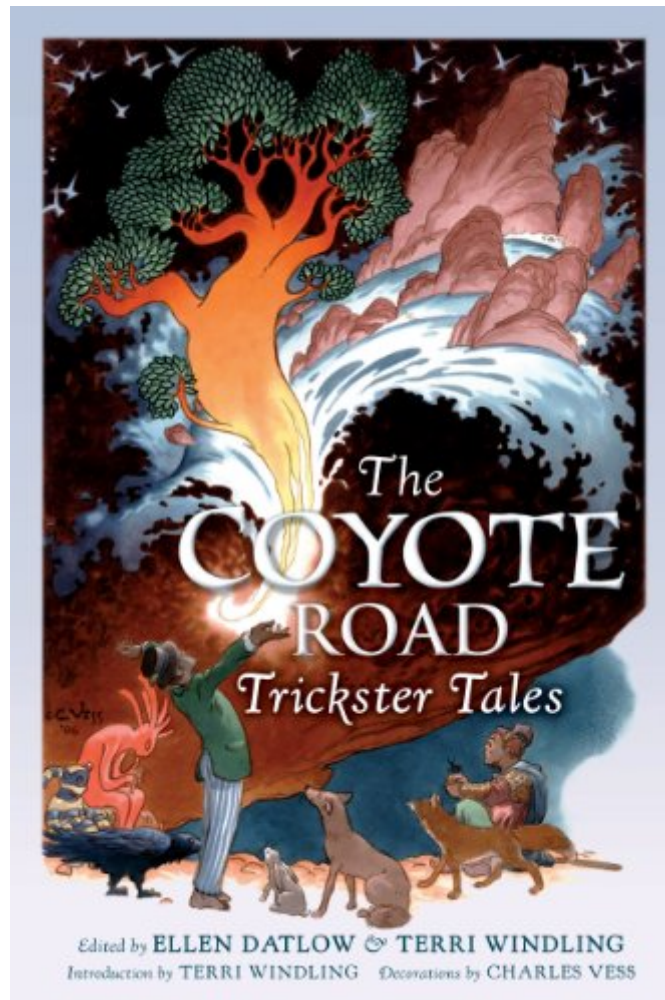

Excellent! I don't usually read short story collections, but I picked this book up about a year ago and have been reading a story or two out of it every so often. Coyote is one of my favorite mythic

creatures. These stories do him/her justice. Some are tragic (the last story about the talking dogs was one of the best and terribly disturbing), some are hilarious, and some are just jaw-droppingly excellent. Highly recommended!

Another brilliant addition to the Datlow/Windling Firebird collections ... I absolutely loved this amassing of brilliant writers and tales. The third in the (so far) 4-book series - The Green Man, The Faery Reel, Coyote Road, The Beastly Bride - Coyote Road is a collection of short stories and poetry concerning our favorite trouble-maker and truth-teller in mythology and folklore: the trickster!
