

I bought this because my 3-year old son's favorite book is Dinosaur Roar! in the same series. I suppose I was expecting some cute poems or actions/voices we could do, but it just lists the color on each page. My son still really likes it, but it isn't really a book we can read so much as just show him which color is which. It is a good variety of colors though.

My son who is 4 yr old loves to read and this is his favorite!

This is a nice 2 in 1 book that the kids enjoy because you get to flip it over and read another book. We like happy dinosaurs around here, and these dinos are perfect. The dinosaur pictures are cute, and not too scary. The only "mean" one is the orange one in the color book... my kids said he looks like a dinosaur tiger. The number side has good rhythm and is easy to read and enjoy. We like to count the number of dinosaurs on each page, and my only complaint is that on some of the pages the dinos are muddled together, making them more difficult to count for young children. The color side works well for teaching colors, but it is only one word (the color) on each page.. Both of my children have "read" and enjoyed this book. The 4 year old has outgrown the color side, but my 2 year old is still learning so he loves the whole thing.

Each page only has one word on it, the featured color, so if you are looking for a storybook... this is not it. The dinosaur pictures are cute, and not too scary. The only "mean" one is the orange one... my kids said he looks like a dinosaur tiger.

My son loved the *Dinosaurs Roar* book by the same authors; it was a bit of a disappointment to find that many of the drawings are the same in the two books. I was hoping for new dinosaurs and a more rich book. This book was not as loved as the other one.

My 10 month-old loves this book! He usually wants to read it over and over. Each page features a different colored dinosaur with the color word printed boldly at the top (simply "RED"). I insert the word "dinosaur" after the color word, so there's a bit more "reading" to be done. The dinosaurs are very cute and friendly looking, most of them smiling. The last page asks, "How many colors have you seen?"

Used this to teach my son colors. He loved the book so he wanted me to read it all of the time. Great fun and great learning tool.
