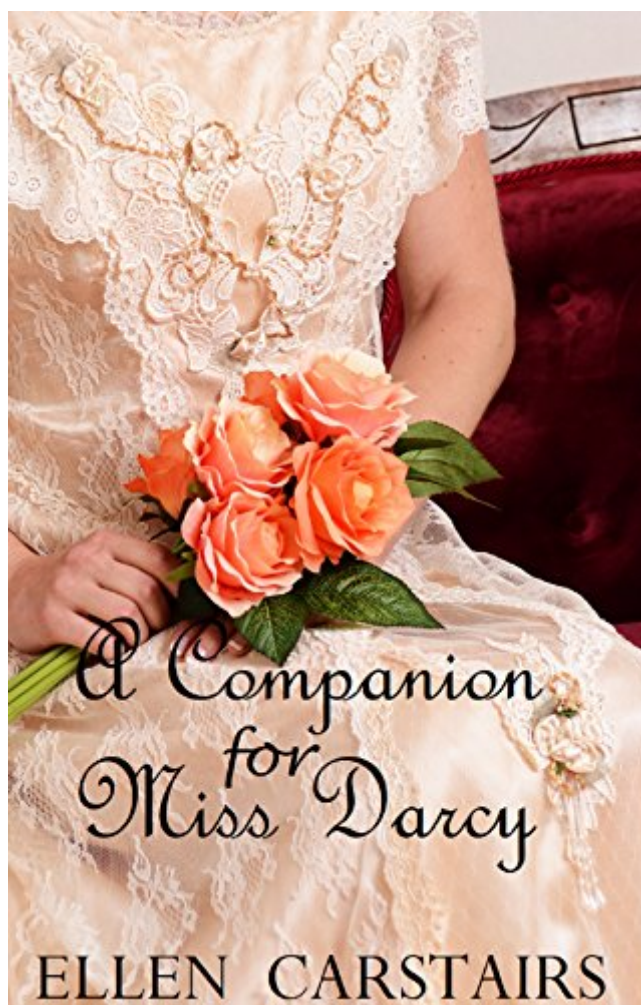


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A Companion For Miss Darcy: A Pride And Prejudice Variation

I enjoyed this story but found it to be a bit choppy. Some characters dropped in, created a situation, then dropped out quickly; e.g. The Colonel, Lady Catherine. I'm never as interested in stories where Darcy and Elizabeth fall instantly in love before they have even walked across the room to greet each other. I find that sort of love unreal. Darcy is also uneven. Comes off as caring and then completely irrational when Wickham enters story. I found his immediate, unquestioning change of trust in Ms Bingley to be a very unbelievable plot point.

The beginning has you already gripped as the tortuous events have already occurred. The Bennets are orphans and Mr Collins is about to visit his inheritance with a view to probably marrying one of his orphaned cousins. With few options available, Jane is determined to do her duty and marry the man no matter how distasteful he turns out to be. Lizzy, on the other hand, is determined to prevent such an outcome unless true love blossoms between them...that won't happen with such an imbecile! Therefore, Elizabeth thinks she can find a position as a governess or companion but such situations are few and harder still to find one paying enough to assist her relatives who are taking in all her sisters. She almost literally has the position of companion to Miss Darcy fall into her lap and even her initial meeting of her new charge is interesting. All goes along well until Wickham is introduced to the neighborhood and Darcy sees Elizabeth attempting to encourage Miss Darcy to converse with him. His ire is immediately up and she is dismissed as another Mrs Younge. How he finds out the truth is a journey worth taking but it is a shame that the few grammatical errors of the beginning increase in number towards the end. It is also a shame that it becomes anticlimactic from the time of their reconciliation. It had been a complete page turner then, okay, something will happen sometime soon, right? Overall, though, it is a nice variation.

The Bennett women are under the care of the Philips because Mr and Mrs Bennett were killed in a carriage accident. Mr Collins has given them several months to stay while he finished his religious studies. Darcy hires Elizabeth as his sister's companion so she can assist with the finances. But Wickham shows up and Darcy takes his sister and returned to London. Caroline convinced him that Elizabeth and Wickham were co-conspirator. But eventually everything works out as it should. Charlotte moves into Longbourne with the stupidest husband in England. Jane moves into Netherfield with the sweetest husband in England. And Elizabeth moves into Pemberley with the richest and best husband in England.

This is a great book. I love these pride and prejudice variation books. I get so wrapped up in the personalities of the characters that I laugh out loud when they tease each other. Thank you for writing it. Please write more.
