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I purchased this when it was first released in 1985; and it is still on my bookcase Twenty Seven years later. There were two; "In Private, In Public - The Prince and Princess of Wales," and this one "In Person - The Prince and Princess of Wales." There was also a video released in conjunction w/ the books.
