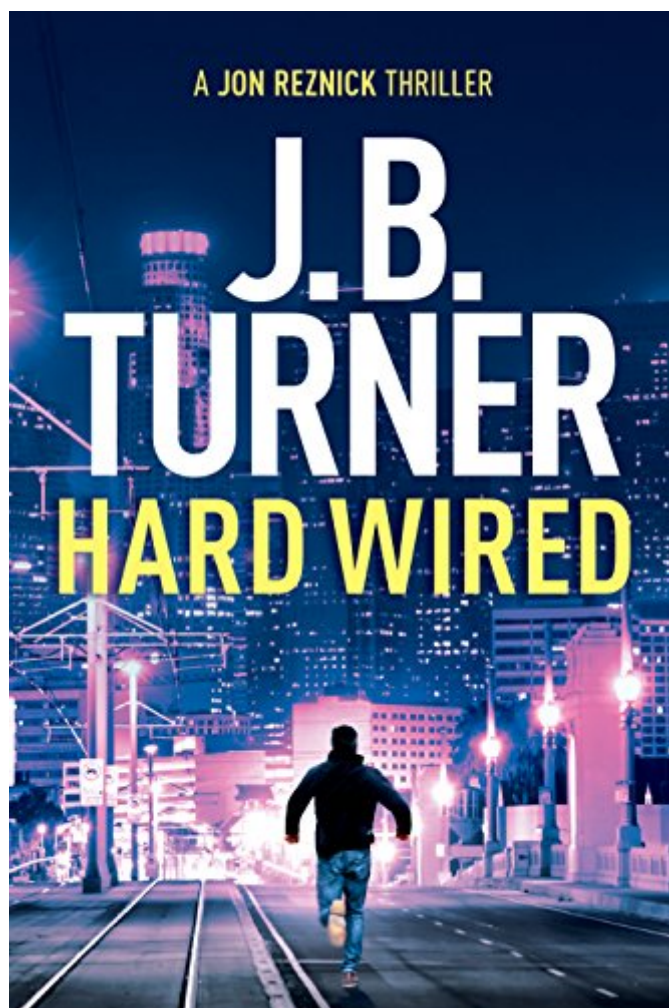

So far the most nail biting book of the series. It starts fast and just keeps getting better and better. You will not want to stop reading till you run out of book. I can't wait till the next installment. The author has been building the people involved in the stories in ways that are fantastic and at the same time not super hero types. In fact one of the main characters is not your typical hero which makes this and the previous books all the better. In my humble opinion J.B. Turner is a excellent story teller as you can see the characters as normal people doing a great job and that makes for very enjoyable reading.

This is a fast acting third story. Reznick realizes that his brothers he fought with within a special service were being killed one by one and he was going after who ever it was. As usual it involves bad government decisions that almost got Reznick killed. Highly recommended, but read books 1 and 2 first.

Not a lot of unbelievable stunts. Not another superhero who can waste bad people at a rate of 25 a page. There is a developing story and sometimes the good guys get hurt. Seems a far more realistic novel and yes the good guy wins even if he has to argue or fight with his own stupid government employers. For those who like realism, don't need the f word on every page and prefer your violence non graphic. This is a book for you.

This three book series is a fun and exciting read. If you like action adventure books you will not be disappointed by this trilogy. That said there is way too much profanity which really degrades the quality of the books.

Stories do not resolve. Book one left situation unresolved. My assumption was that it would pick up in book two or three. It didn't. Bad guys are still in government and no more books in series. Bad officials in Pentagon are still there. Corruption needs to be revealed not just in middle guys.

Great read. Alert: lots of foul language. Other than that, excellent writing & story. Makes you want to read the next book.
