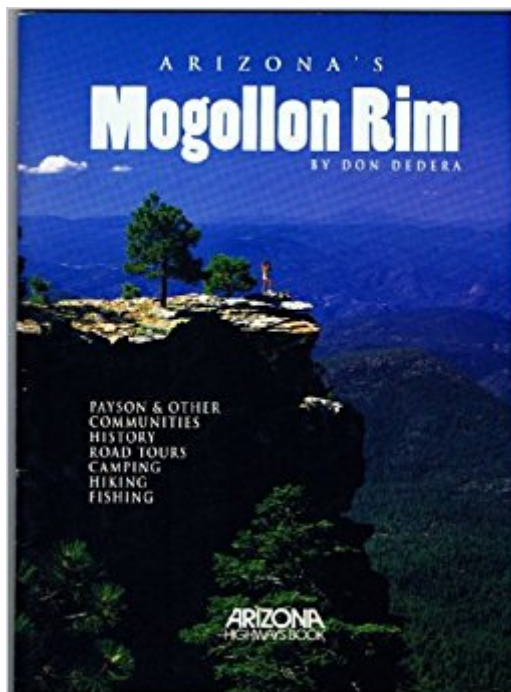

Introducing readers to a virtual year-round outdoor playground, the guide describes springtime canoeing in pristine lakes, summer hiking through pine forests and boulder-strewn streams, autumn strolls beneath golden canopies of quaking aspen, and Nordic-style skiing in snow-packed fields. Anglers will find good descriptions of lakes in the area as well as fishing tips.
