

Another very fine short read from Vivi Holt! I enjoyed this book, it is filled with adventure and love. Hattie has been sent by her parents to the west as a mail order bride, after her parents lose their wealth. When she finally arrives, she has been robbed on the stage and her fiancé Jack Miller is nowhere to be found. She meets the Sheriff, Ed finds her a room to stay in at Sally's at her saloon. Ed takes a real liking to Hattie, while he is away working Jack Miller shows up and grabs Hattie and rushes her off to be married. Ed is distraught when he hears they have gotten married, but he runs into Hattie as she is running away from her new husband. When the justice of the peace pronounces Jack and Hattie man and wife and says he can kiss his bride, Hattie gets a good look at Jack's face close up and sees the scar on his face and realizes Jack is one of the robbers who held up the stage she was on. She runs away and runs straight into Sheriff Ed, telling him Jack is the stage robber. Jack runs away, the sheriff goes after him but they don't find him.
