

Visited Patagonia, and even though this book wasn't focused solely on Patagonia, it had enough information to truly enhance our trip! (It also covered information on Argentina's Patagonia, which was also helpful, as we hadn't initially planned on going there, but decided to, after all.) The book recommended an excursion that is no longer in business, related to viewing penguins. Had we not checked first, it could have been a long 'detour', for nothing (which would have been upsetting, as it would have cost us 1/2 day to drive there and back, only to learn it was closed/no longer in business). Thankfully, we talked to people first, and checked the internet. That was a great reminder, to always check for the latest information, before venturing out. We are glad we purchased the book, and it was worth the 'extra weight', carrying it along!
