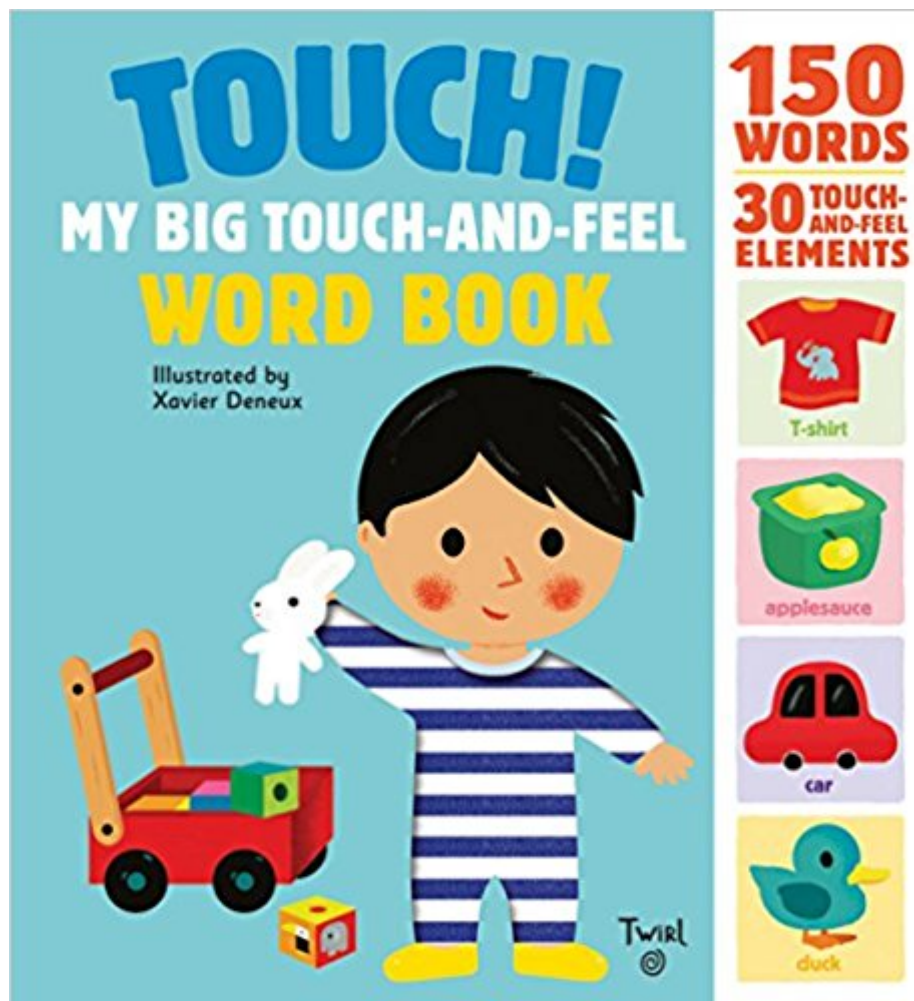

There are all kinds of board books, but once again, none quite as fun as the ones Xavier Deneux creates. Yes, these are simply works of art for the preschooler to explore. They're a

wonderful way to introduce the world around us via the sense of touch, a wonderful way to introduce them to the written word. Similar to the TouchThinkLearn books, this is an oversized picture book that can be worked with on a table. No doubt, when you least expect it, the pages of this book will be turning. Homeschoolers will definitely jump at the chance for the opportunity to introduce this tactile marvel of a book to their little ones. Each one or two-page spread introduces an activity or a group of things that are familiar to preschoolers. These pages include Meal Time, Bedtime, Playtime, Bath Time, Clothes, At the Market, At the Table, On the Road, Animals with Short Hair, Furry Animals, Animals with Smooth Skin, Animals with Rough Skin, Animals with Scales and Shells, and Birds. Combined with a wide variety of tactile experiences, this book is an excellent learning tool. The tactile experiences are quite varied and present a wide variety of unique Touch-And-Feel Elements. This is a fun, fascinating book that is the perfect complement to the TouchThinkLearn series of books. Whenever someone wants a recommendation for young children, this is the direction I point them in. These books will definitely awaken any preschooler's sensory system with the Touch-And-Feel Elements, the vibrant colors, familiar items, new words, and little surprises like that sticky piece of toast! The intended age group for this Touch-And-Feel book is 2 - 4, but for the younger set, I'd certainly recommend some supervision. This oversize first word book offers up plenty of opportunities for very young ones to practice their new vocabulary. The book travels from "meal time" to "bedtime", and "play time" to "bath time", showing pictures and words of 6-7 common items. We are then treated to several two page spreads

filled with pictures and words in the following categories: "clothes", "at the market", "at the table", and "on the road". This surprisingly comprehensive first word book then offers up several pages of animals, dividing them up by texture. It's a unique approach that was mostly successful, although I wish the section for "animals with rough skin" would have actually had some rougher textures. That was the only failing in this charming arrangement. The illustrations in this book are uniquely cartoonish, which is great from an entertainment standpoint, but not quite as effective from an educational view. Let's face it, these illustrations are just flat out adorable. The animals all look like baby animals, and the little boy tucked into his cozy bed is a rosy cheeked little cherub. Kids will love turning these pages, feeling the sticky, furry, scaly and rough. Although some of the spreads could have used a bit more realism and a bit less cute, kids will learn some new words and have fun doing it thanks to the unique organization and design of a board book that is surprisingly sturdy and oh so appealing. *Received from publisher for review purposes.

~ review copy received from the publisher MY BIG TOUCH-AND-FEEL WORD BOOK is one of my favorite 'touch' books. What gets it my praise is that it combines all the merits of the better picture-and-name books with the touch-activity that most little ones enjoy. This is a large book (9.8 x 1.1 x 9.8 inches) with boardbook type pages. The images are bright and appealing and each page or page-duet deals with a category such as Meal Time or Clothes. I'll list the groups that covered below, but for Meal Time, for example, the page shows a large baby bottle, a bib, spoon, high chair, sippy cup, bowl and sponge. Categories: Meal Time Bedtime Clothes At the Market At the Table On the Road Furry Animals Animals with Smooth Skin Animals with Rough Skin Animals with Scales and Shells Birds As you can see there is a lot to share so you'll be able to start out by pointing out things your older baby has seen, like the bottle, and move on to naming animals and textures over time. The textures are delightfully broad. Besides the fuzzy soft blanket there is a shiny smooth mirror, and denim pants and a corduroy jacket. I happen to like the fact that the potatoes on the Market page are in a touchable burlap sack, and that the toast on the next page is truly sticky. In my opinion this MY BIG TOUCH-AND-FEEL WORD BOOK would make a great gift or purchase for the home shelves because of the great size, the sturdy pages, and how much material that is inside that you can share with little ones.
