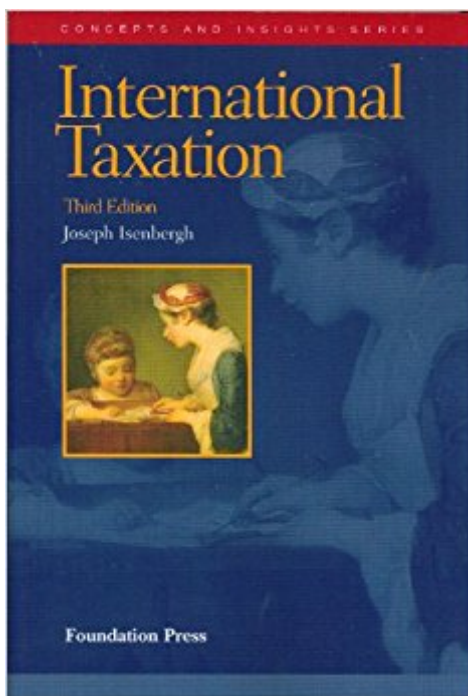

The book is well written, but it is very cursory. It does not fully explain many rules and was little use to me in my JD-level international tax class. I would definitely recommend the Nutshell book by Doernberg over this book. The Doernberg has an indexes by subject matter, IRC code sections, cases, revenue rulings and treasury regulations. This hornbook only has indexes by subject matter and cases. For a tax hornbook, having an index for IRC code sections is pretty key.

I bought this for a project at work. I needed something that would have the basic information for me to do a quick over the weekend read in order to be ready for a conference call Monday morning. I wasn't disappointed. It was a concise and straightforward. I was able to understand the conversation and the important concepts relatively easily and in minimal time.
