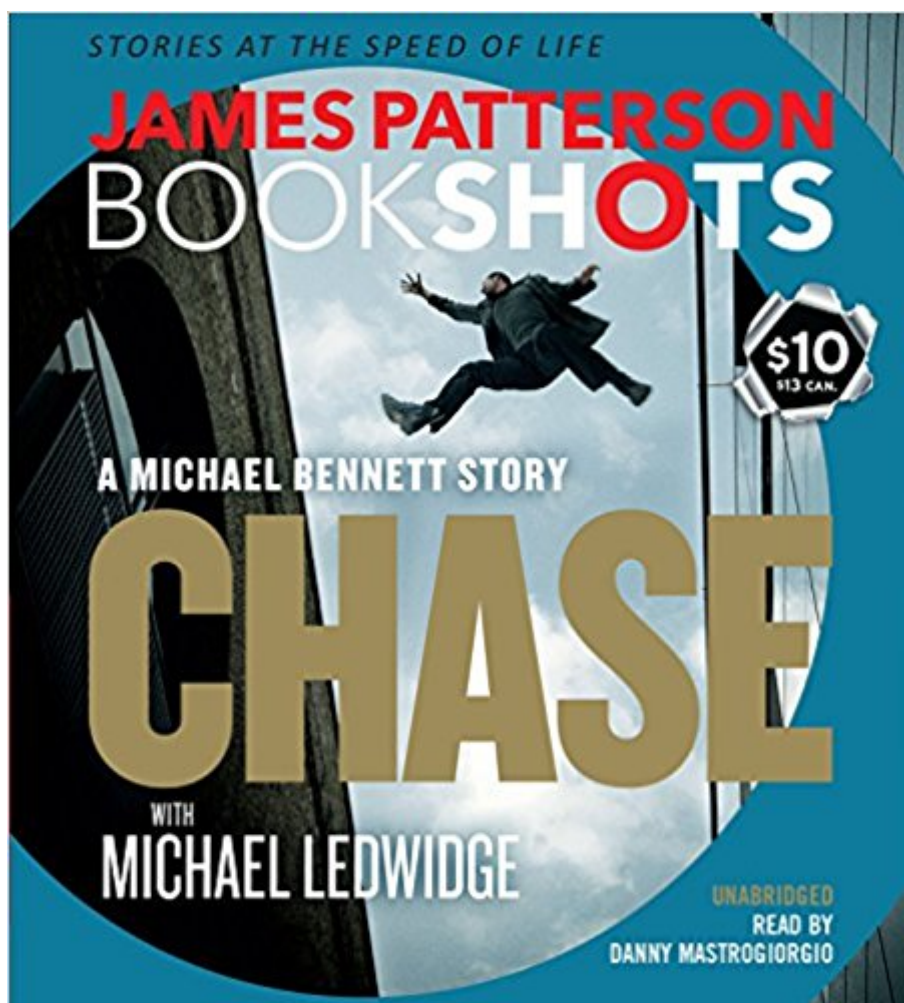

James Patterson has written more bestsellers and created more enduring fictional characters than any other novelist writing today. He lives in Florida with his family. Since the debut of his first novel *The Narrowback*, Michael Ledwidge has written fourteen additional novels, a dozen of them New York Times bestsellers co-authored with James Patterson.

Don't like any of the BookShots. Would rather wait on an entire book. All that I've read just fall short.

This is a good book, but if you enjoy Mary Catherine and the ten kids, they are not prominent in this book. This deterred from the plot. Family aside, Michael used super human powers to solve his case.

I dislike these Hot Shots, they are a rip off of my money and a disappointment to your fans. Quit it.

I thought that the concept of a "book shot" had potential, but I expected a tightly written work akin to a short story. It is not. It is an interesting plot idea that seems hastily written and unpolished.

Quick OverviewSuspension of disbelief was a bit more challenging with this Michael Bennet story, for me, than it was for the full-length novel, Bullseye. Stating precisely why, though, could result in a spoiler. Suffice it to say that I had a conceptual disagreement that an NYPD detective would traipse down to Washington D.C. Still, I do enjoy the writing of the author combination of James Patterson and Michael Ledwidge. Length: Print, 144 pages. Q - Target Audience/Genre and is it marketed as Nonfiction or Fiction? A "Adults Suspense; Political-Crime" Q - How was this book obtained? A "Bought on .Q" Q - If this is fiction, is it a plot-driven or a character-driven story? A "Plot driven." Q - Is this a book that I can read without having to read others first? A "Yes. This is a stand-alone story, but to gain a better feel for the lead character, I would suggest reading also some of the other stories. Note that the newest release with Michael Bennet is Bullseye and is in the Top 100 on Kindle" Bullseye Q "If this is a recurring character or a series, does it have a cliffhanger ending?" A "No cliffhanger ending." Q - Are there a lot of typos/misspellings, grammatical errors or other editing failures? A "No." Q - Is this a fast, easy read or is it more of a leisure read? A "This is a short, fast, easy read." Q - What sort of language does this writer use to amplify the points made? A "Adult English, including a few f-bombs. In my opinion, though, the frequency is not gratuitous and the use is consistent with the characters." Q "What age group is this suitable for?" A "If this were a film, it likely would be rated PG-13 for language." Q - My biggest pleasure or disappointment? A "Only very minor points that aren't serious enough for me to be disappointed. As stated elsewhere, suspension of disbelief was a challenge, but, hey, this is still a fun read. To give a feel for the editing, and the style and flow of this work, I am posting a brief excerpt below.
