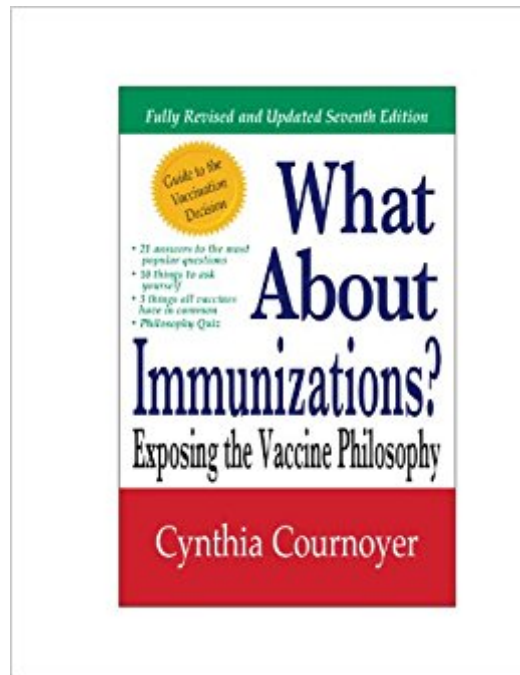

She provides historical information, and with this seventh edition, brings us up-to-date with current information regarding vaccines for children and adults. She is honest about her opinions and yet provides information for the readers to assess for themselves. She lists her references at the end of each chapter. She

provides great food for thought including the metaphor of a seed in the soil. Bacteria and viruses are all around us, and in us, but they are not able to do damage if we maintain good health. She advocates being health-oriented rather than disease-oriented.

Should be required reading for every parent, or (especially) anyone about to become one.

This is a book that every parent, health care worker and overseas traveller should read. So many people vaccinate themselves as well as their children with blind faith when they could easily do the research. There is much to be learned from this book as it is very compelling and informative.
