

State prior to beginning a 25-year career with Hilb, Rogal, and Hamilton, a property and casualty insurance firm. He was CEO of that firm for ten years. Much of Richard's life has been devoted to giving back to the community by working with youth as well as advising businessmen and professionals. Through these experiences, he discovered he had a gift and inclination for teaching and public speaking. In December of 2000 Simmons founded the Center for Executive Leadership, a non-profit, faith-based ministry. This book is a searing look into a man's soul. There were times when I was not sure if I were reading the book or if it were reading me. Simmons begins by examining every man's secret fears and, at least for me, he was right on target. He discusses pride, the place of money and job, and ambition. He contends that none of these is effective at self-esteem and that each will ultimately fail. Simmons eventually offers a counterintuitive alternative: surrender to Jesus Christ. This book is well organized and it is an easy but profound read. It takes about 2 1/2 hours to read.
