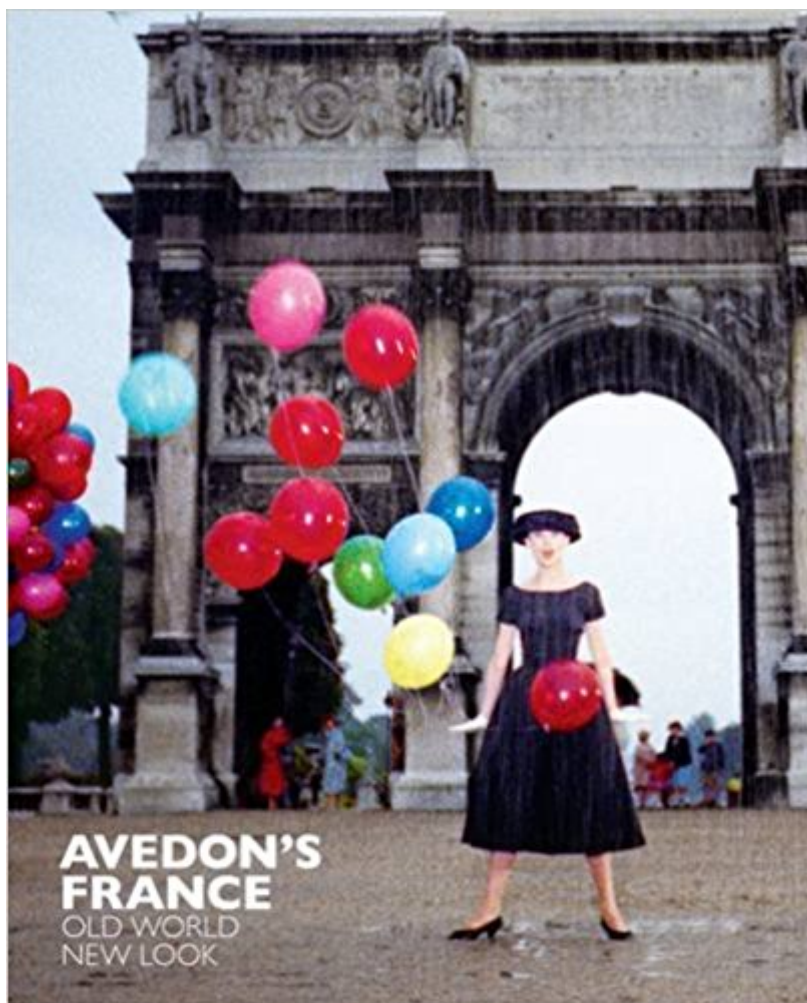

Synopsis

Exploring Richard Avedon's fascination with France, *Avedon's France* brings together a collection of spectacular photographs; selected interviews, letters, publications, and writings (including new material from the Avedon Foundation archives); and substantive essays by the authors. In addition to five portfolios of French sitters spanning a lifetime of portraiture, it looks at Avedon's apprenticeship to his mentor, Alexei Brodovitch; his encounters with French fashion; his idealized version of Paris in the movie *Funny Face*; his fresh take on the belle époque in his book on Jacques-Henri Lartigue, *Diary of a Century*; and his fruitful association with the magazine *Ego*—ste later in his life. *Avedon's France* offers a full account of Avedon's restless pursuit of new ways of looking at the world, and it reveals a master image maker, a true artist for his time.
