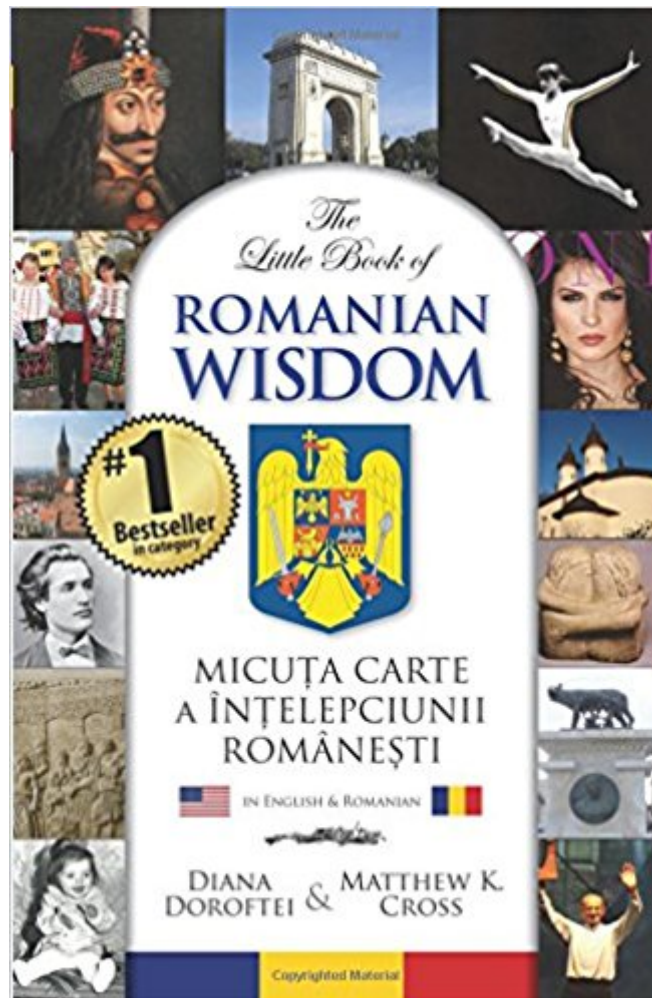


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The Little Book Of Romanian Wisdom (English And Romanian Edition)

It displays much of the heritage and culture of this diverse land of contrasts, and introduces Romanians who have played important roles in the world without making a point of their birthplace. The book closes with an appendix which contains a brief history of Romania, a collection of essential Romanian words spelled phonetically for English speakers (Yes, "Da
