

Today, National Geographic Maps continues this mission by creating the world's best wall maps, recreation maps, atlases, and globes which inspire people to care about and explore their world.

I bought it for my trip across the US. Ok, I had my GPS, but we must always have a map on us. It is very useful, because you can find a lot of information.

Great map of Yellowstone, and I looked at several on-line before choosing this one. Unlike many Yellowstone maps, this one has the campsites clearly labeled. It also shows trail mileage. An important map to have if you're hiking in the backcountry and we used it many times. We camped along Cache Creek, the Lamar River, and the Slough, all of which are on this map. It was totally helpful. Yellowstone trails are as a whole very clearly marked, but this gave us a way to think about entering the water to fish by leaving trails, and allowed us to plan when to leave the river to return to the camp (often an hour or more walk back in the evening). Also the map is water- and tear-resistant which is very nice. It may not be the toughest map, but it should withstand most typical hiking trips. Contour lines -totally necessary for a hiking map - are 50 ft.

It looks, at the Trails Illustrated web site, like this NE map includes only a portion of the Pelican Valley hike to Lamar Valley. This is NOT the case. The NE map (I just got one) shows the ENTIRE hike from start to end. No need for any other map unless you want a driving map or something else for some other reason. From the Pelican Valley trailhead to the Lamar trailhead, this "304 Northeast Yellowstone - Tower & Canyon Trail Map" is all you need. So, what I'm saying is, this map covers a larger area than it appears to cover on any web site that I could find that had pictures of the map. It's very strange that the Trails Illustrated web site CLEARLY shows the map bottom cutting off the first part of the hike. Anyway...there you have it. JL
