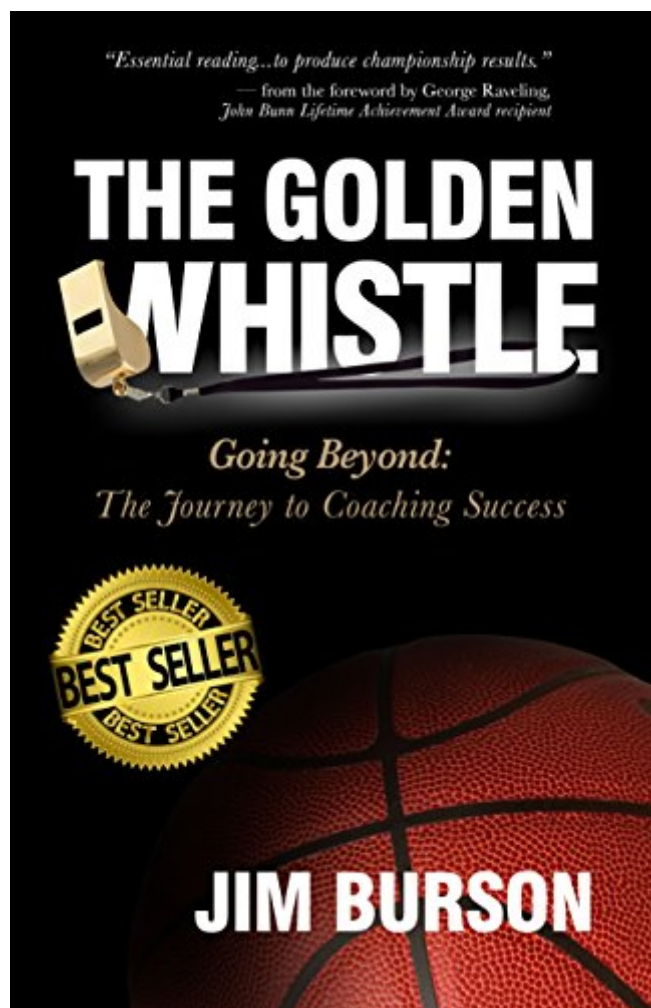

I have spent a coaching lifetime in southern Ohio and have grown professionally watching Coach Burson's Muskingum College teams, listening to him at coaching clinics, observing his practices and seeking his counsel for over 40 years. I anxiously awaited the release of this book, and have not

been disappointed. Dr. Burson's story, uniquely written, presents deep questions of beginning and experienced coaches alike in the formation of core values that will maximize a coach's influence on student-athletes. However, this book cuts to the heart issues of a coach, challenges him to see and do the right things for the right reasons, and grow personally as well as professionally from the experience of truly pursuing excellence. In a "style over substance" culture, this book has weighty subject matter for thought and reflection.
