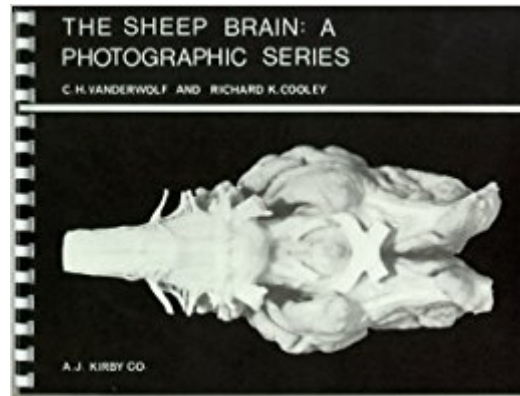

Synopsis

An advanced laboratory guide for the study of neuroanatomy using the sheep brain as dissection material. Clear B/W labelled photographs of the brain: dorsal, ventral, lateral, and sagittal views; serial cross sections, and horizontal sections, and dissections showing major structures and fiber tracts. Appendices provide additional material. Appendix I contains labelled photographs of common laboratory animals: Rat, Cat, and Rhesus monkey. Appendix II contains photomicrographs, with accompanying text, of selected parts of the nervous system and of sense organs. Appendix III contains a series of schematic diagrams, with accompanying text, illustrating important brain circuits.

This book is required for my neuroanatomy course and it is easy to read with great pictures of the sheep brain. I will be using this book as a guide for my master's project on the Grizzly Bear's Brain!

We use the sheep brain in my neuroanatomy lab. This is a helpful tool, although I don't use it all that much. I think it would be better if the pictures were in color.

An excellent manual. The manual provides sagittal, horizontal and coronal views of the sheep brain, with slices that are of excellent quality. In addition, there are gross dissections that allow students an excellent understanding of the relations between the basic structures of the ventral brain. Most of us who get sheep brains for our labs from laboratory supply houses can only dream of the cranial nerves shown in clear detail here. At the University of Guelph, we are one of the few holdout universities that offer the sheep brain dissection to large introductory biopsychology classes, and although excellent photographic series are available on the Web, nothing can replace actually going through a sheep brain. This manual is very, very helpful in this pursuit. Highly recommended.

First off, you will also want *The Sheep Brain: A Basic Guide* by Richard K. Cooley to go along with this. This book is more lab-manual style than the other book, but has the same great qualities - it is meant to be right by your side when you are dissecting, not in the library. If you're concerned, it's easy to photocopy for personal use. The main thing I like about this and the other book is that the price is right for any budget. You shouldn't have to pay more for the book than you do for the brains :)
