

I found this book on when I was looking for a gift for my barely 6-year-old grandson. There were

only 2 reviews so I checked to see if my local library carried it. They did so I looked through it. I could tell immediately that it would interest him. It was only \$4 and he LOVES it. There are real pictures of knights that come from current re-enactments, and that makes it seem very real to my grandson. He is fascinated with it. I thought the section on castles might not interest him, but it does. I would highly recommend this book for probably 5 to 8 year-olds. I can't verify that all in the information in it is 100% accurate, but that is not my concern for a 6 year old that thinks knights are invincible!
