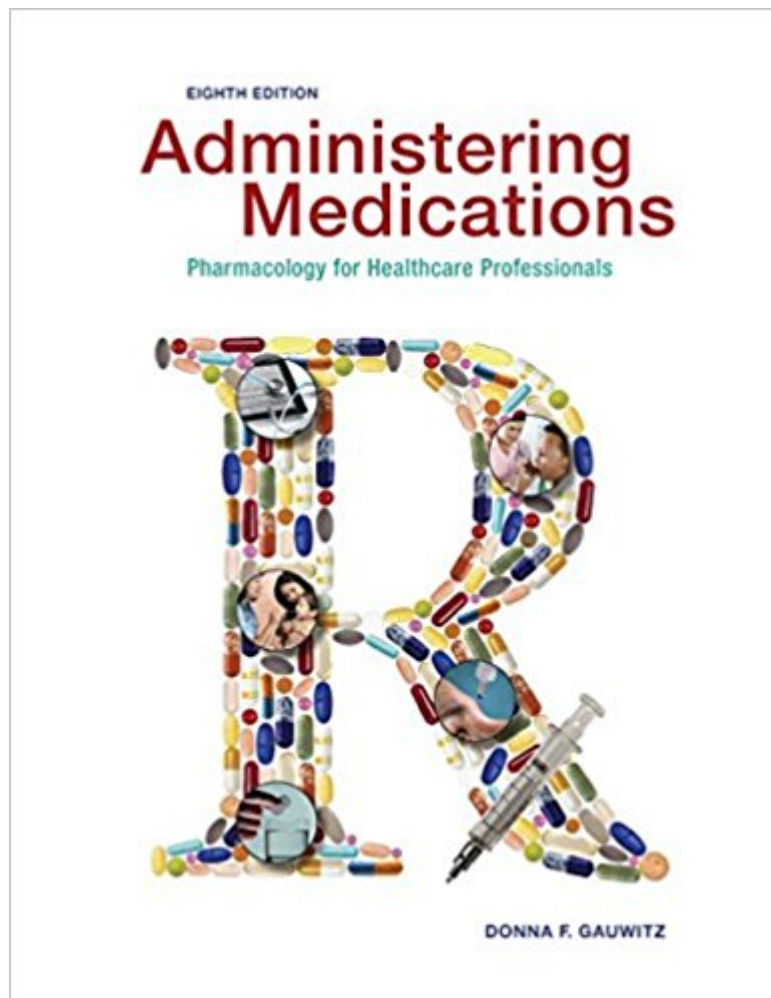




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Administering Medications - Standalone Book (P.S. Health Occupations)
