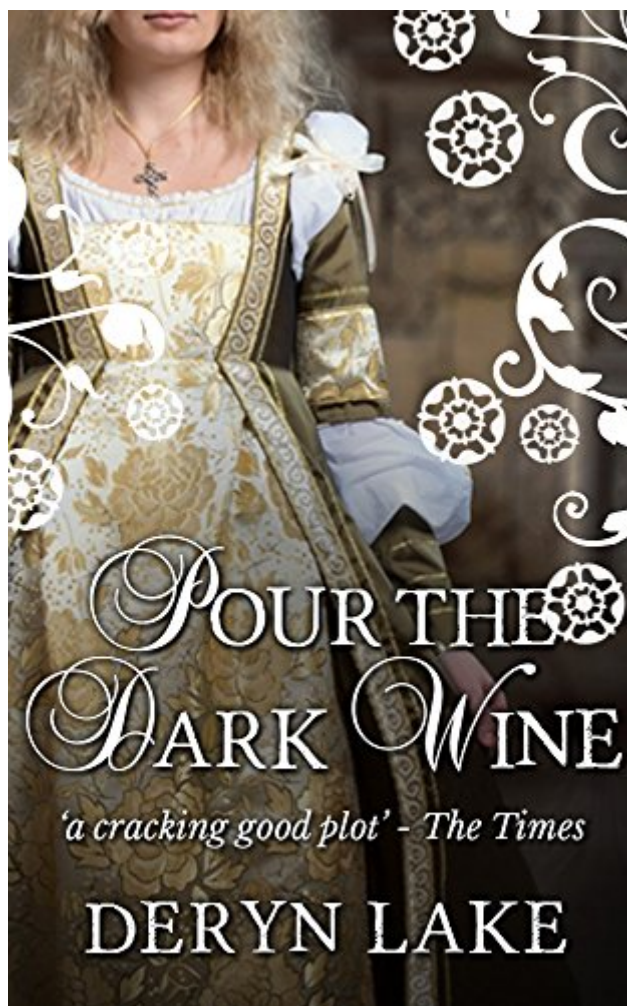

Pour yourself a nice cup of tea, curl up in a favorite chair and enjoy this excellent historical novel. Wonderfully written, it seamlessly weaves fictional characters and events with historical ones. It is one of the best of this genre I have read in a long while.

I love this book. I'm very much into Henry VIII and his wives and this book covers all of them. People die, of course, but there is no graphic detail which for me is wonderful. I usually skip over all that - I love the era but hate the torture. This is more a story of the people and their relationships and makes everyone much more human than some books do. Of course it's an Historical Novel and as such much of it comes directly from the author's mind - but that's OK. There are plenty of straight history books out there which tend to be dry and boring. Not this book. I have been reading a little bit each night trying to make it last as long as possible.

I highly recommend this book for anyone who thinks they have already read all the good Tudor historical fiction. Very interesting and believable character insights on Jane Seymour and her son Edward the VI. I thoroughly enjoyed this book.
