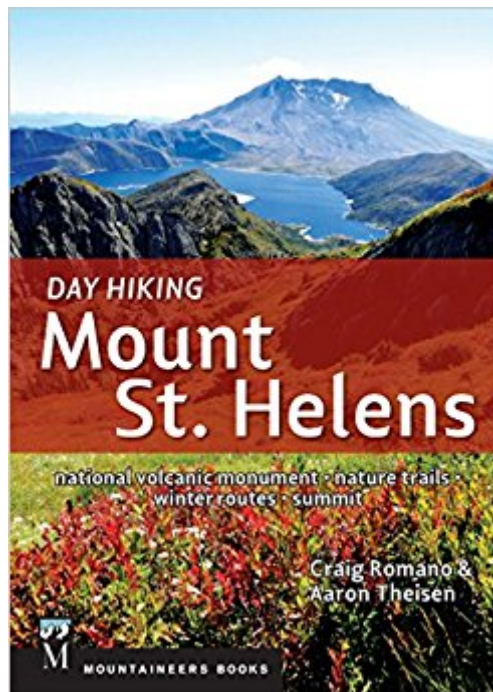

Encompassing the entire monument, Craig and Aaron also include in the book, hikes in the adjacent Dark Divide and Siouxsie Roadless areas; and the Chehalis and Cowlitz River valleys. Nowhere else in the Northwest can you witness on such a large scale the sheer destructive and rejuvenating forces of Nature than at Mount St. Helens!

Craig has written about his outdoor passions for dozens of publications, including Seattle Met, Backpacker, Paddler, Adventures NW, AMC Outdoors, Washington Trails, and CityDog. He is currently a columnist for Northwest Runner, Outdoors NW, and The Mountaineer, and is the author or co-author of 14 guidebooks. This guide book is easy to use and gives excellent trail descriptions with directions of how to get to the trailheads included. It is arranged by region with an overview map at the beginning. A chart of "Hikes at a Glance" provides a quick reference regarding difficulty, bike use, kid friendliness, dog friendliness, and wheelchair accessibility. After checking out the overview map and the "Hikes at a Glance" I was able to easily narrow down the list of hikes that appealed to me and then read the detailed descriptions for those hikes. The book includes some nice photos that give a good representation of the terrain and scenery.

What a great resource for hiking the Mt. St. Helens area. The book goes into a lot of detail about trails that you simply won't find anywhere else. I'm going to be purchasing their other day hiking books for the Pacific Northwest!
