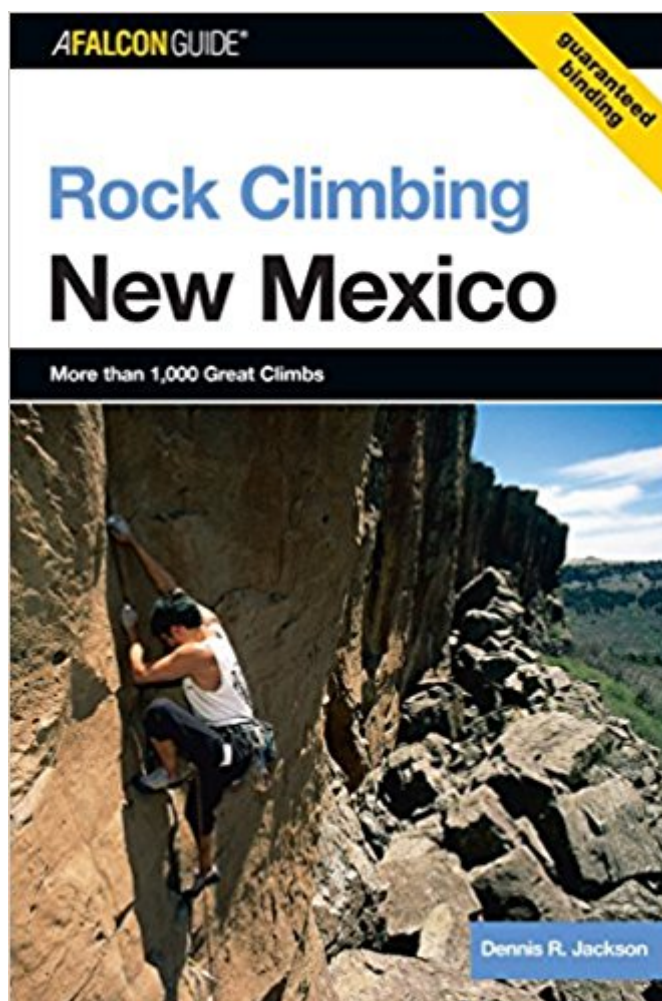


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# Rock Climbing New Mexico (State Rock Climbing Series)
