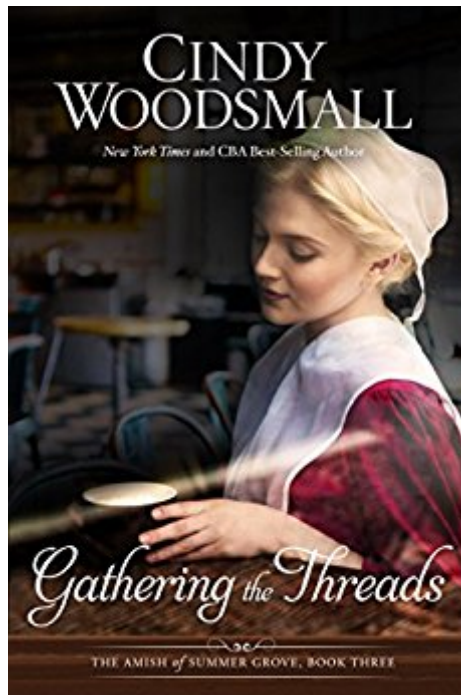




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# Gathering The Threads: A Novel (The Amish Of Summer Grove)

While it could be read as a stand alone book as the author provides a "the story so far" blurb in the beginning I highly recommend reading the first two books! Without giving too much away the story focuses on two girls who grew up in very different worlds-one Amish and one English- and through a twist of fate, or maybe God's hand, they were forced into each other's lives and worlds. I often find Amish Fiction a bit predictable though I still love it. Cindy Woodsmall's books, and this one especially, is far from predictable.
