

## **Synopsis**

It is home to about 1,800 different types of birds from the mighty Andean Condor to a dazzling variety of jewel-like hummingbirds. The genuine pocket size allow the books to be carried around on trips and excursions and will take up minimal rucksack and suitcase space.
