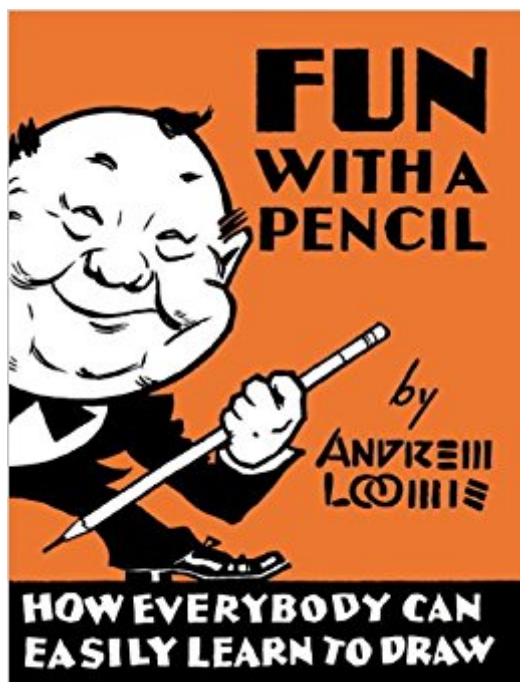

Andrew Loomis was born in 1892. After studying art he moved to Chicago, eventually opening his own studio, working in editorial and advertising for most of the top clients at the time including Kellogg's, Coca Cola, Lucky Strike and more. He also became renowned as an art teacher and his instructional books on realist illustration and art are acclaimed classics in the field. He died in 1959.

I have studied and practiced from many books, but remain a beginner. Somehow, the lessons in this book seem better grounded, and I find myself progressing faster than I have before. I am working from the Kindle version, which seems entirely adequate. But I am working from a Kindle Fire. This would not work well from a regular Kindle that lacks color, as some of the instruction definitely requires it. But I find this useful on an iPad, my Kindle Fire, and on my Mac.
