

Stan and Jan Berenstain were already successful cartoonists for magazines and adult humor books when they began writing children's books. The first story starring the bear family, The Big Honey Hunt, appeared in 1962. Since then, more than 360 Berenstain Bears books have been published, and more than 300 million copies have been sold. What began as an idea sparked by their young sons' love of reading has become one of the best-selling children's book series ever.

Bought this for my two year old grandson before their move. He loves it and asked for parents to read it for 100 times.

Yet another classic Berenstain Bears story. We have about 20 of these classic books and my kids love them. In our family, our son is two years older than our daughter so it really helps them connect to the stories because they often put themselves in the positions of the characters. We are moving soon so I ordered this book. Even though it came out in 1981 (after Sister Bear was introduced), it is a flashback story of the time when the only child Brother Bear (along with his parents -- obviously) move from their cave to the tree house that is the common back drop for most of their stories. I have yet to encounter one of the classic books by Stan and Jan Berenstain that I don't like (plus, my kids love them which is wonderful too). The only negative that we experienced with this book is that my daughter had a tough time because Sister Bear wasn't in it. She still liked the story and we talked about how we are going to pack up their toys and games and still be able to enjoy them at our new house. Plus, we talked about how we will be meeting new friends in our new neighborhood, and won't be able to see our current friends and neighbors as often.

We were very concerned about our children and our upcoming move. We started reading this book to them a month before and pointed out all of the parallels that would soon take place with them. They were so excited about their new adventure and this book was a huge help in their transition!

My boys like this book. You can't go wrong with the Berenstain Bears.

We LOVED having this book for our move. My daughter is 2.5 and we wanted something to help her process our move from CA to CO. This book helped tremendously. No negativity, like I saw in some other book reviews. Just a nice little book about moving. Highly recommend!

Good story for young children about moving, especially if they are already fond of the Berenstain Bears. In our young person's case, the moving truck did not exactly follow the family moving, but it is easy to explain that to a child (taking your moving truck longer because it has to go across the country, etc.). But this is a pretty good story about packing up, stuff going into a truck for the move, moving into new home, making new friends.

Great book to help explain moving to your children.
